2007 Austin "Impeach Now" Forum

Austin, TX
July 3, 2007

The Austin "Impeach Now" Forum will be held on Saturday, July 7 (07/07/07), at the First Unitarian-Universalist Church at 4700 Grover in central Austin. The event will start at 3:30 with music and the "I Miss America" Pageant by the Austin chapter of CodePink. The forum itself will kick off at 4:00, with the following speakers and topics:

1. Larry Everest – Conspiracy to Defraud Congress Regarding Iraq
Lying to Congress and the American people about the need to invade Iraq; manipulating and fabricating intelligence to deceive Congress and the United Nations; fabricating a link between Iraq and 9/11.
2. Dennis Loo – War Crimes and Treaties Violated in Iraq, Guantanamo, and Afghanistan
Violation of United Nations & Nuremberg Treaties in Iraq; use of torture and banned weapons; cover-up and protection of responsible parties in Abu Ghraib; continuing the war in Iraq after the authorizing conditions no longer apply.
3. David Lindorff – Obstruction of Justice and Possible Treason
Falsifying the Niger "yellowcake" documents; disclosure of the identity of a working CIA agent; failure to protect US troops; failure to protect New Orleans; refusal to join the global effort to mitigate the coming global climate change.
4. Elaine Brown – Abuse of Powers
Warrantless felony wiretapping, even after Attorney General ruled it illegal; refusal to comply with subpoenas; election fraud in 2000 and 2004; Cheney's claim to be a separate branch of government; openly threatening the nation of Iran.
